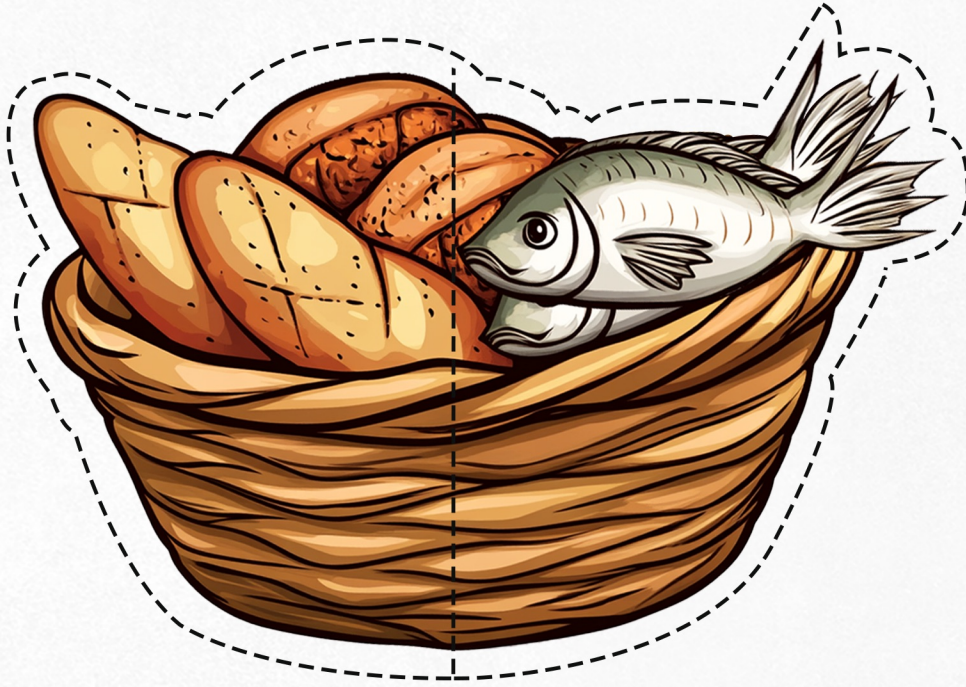


Jesus Feeds the 5,000

Huge crowds followed Jesus, eager to hear his teachings and see his miracles. As evening approached, they grew hungry, far from any village.



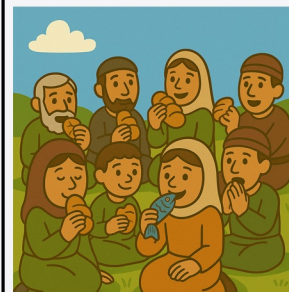
Jesus' disciples worried, urging him to send the crowds away to find food. But Jesus calmly told them, "You give them something to eat."

Amazingly, everyone—about five thousand men, plus women and children—ate their fill. The small meal multiplied miraculously.

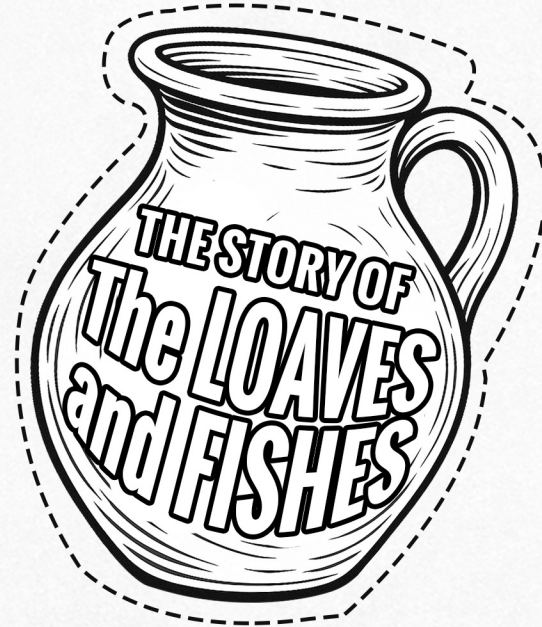
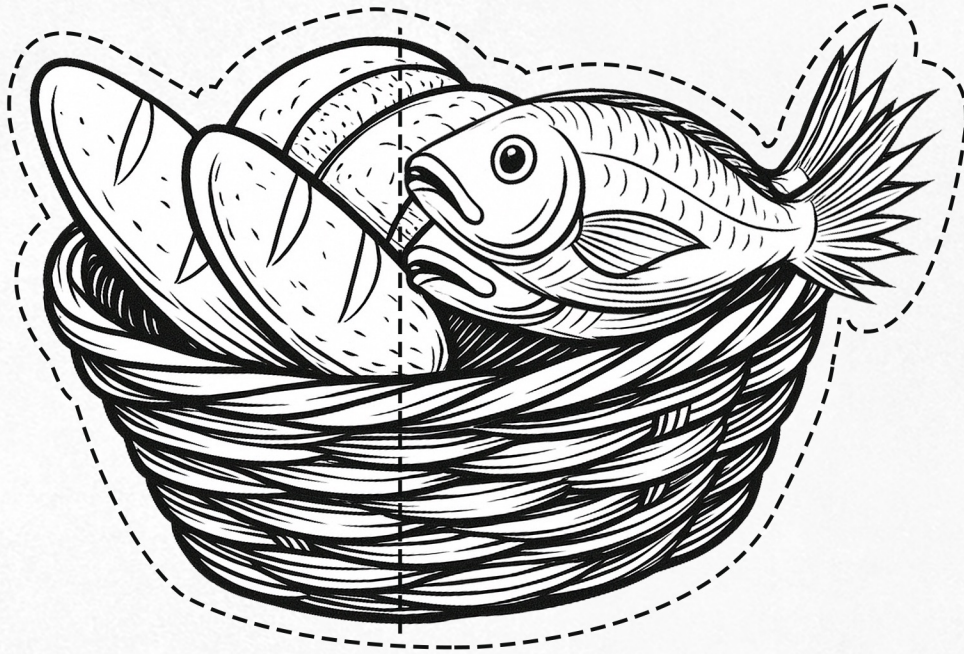

Jesus Feeds the 5,000

COLORING SHEET

STEP 1 :

Carefully cut out the basket, water jug, and story strip along the dotted lines.

STEP 2 :

Use glue or tape to attach the water jug to the side of the basket

STEP 3 :

Attach the story strip to the bottom halves of the basket using glue or tape, aligning it along the indicated edge

STEP 4 :

Fold the story strip along each line in an accordion style, so each part of the story layers neatly.
