



Parable of the Lost Sheep COLORING SHEET

STEP 1:

Carefully cut out the sheep, wool, and the story strip along the dotted lines.

STEP 2:

Use glue or tape to attach the wool to the sheep

STEP 3:

glue or tape both sides of the story strip to both halves of the sheep

STEP 4:

Fold the story strip along each line in an accordion style, so each part of the story layers neatly.
